TRADE	<i>Operating Engineer- STATIONARY 0536R1</i>
WORK DESCRIPTION	<p>Operating, starting, stopping and adjusting: Boilers and Auxiliaries- Water Systems- Fuels Burners and Systems- Controls and Instruments Electrical Equipment – Miscellaneous Equipment.</p> <p>Checking and recording while plant is operating: All Moving Parts, Pressures, Temperatures, Level Flows, Meters, Control Settings, Concentrations Operating loads, Record Operating Date, Plant Safety.</p> <p>Testing: Controls and Instruments, Safety and Relief Devices, System and Zone Load Balance, With Chemicals.</p> <p>Maintenance: Preliminary use of tools, Blueprint Reading/Drawing, Welding/Oxy-Acetylene cutting, Pipe-Fitting Repair, Power Tools, Adjusting Bearings/etc., Electrical Repair, Controls and Instrumentation, and Lubrication.</p>
WORKING CONDITIONS	In-climate weather, outside and inside, exposed to extremely hot and cold weather. Noisy conditions. Extremely physical work including bending and heavy lifting. Required to wear personal protective equipment such as hard hats, safety glasses, hearing protection, safety shoes, gloves, etc.
TRAINING	An apprentice who seeks this branch of training shall be required to complete 6,000 hours of on-the-job training and have 432 related instruction hours to complete this Trade.
LOCATION OF TRAINING	Training Site- 3508 Los Picaros Rd SE., Albuquerque, NM 87105
TRAVEL	No travel required for training time. Upon employment travel time could be required depending on contractor/employer needs.
APPLICATIONS	Applications are sent out as they are requested. Orientation and acceptance are based on the need for more Apprentices and when an

orientation is set up. Orientation will be 1-2 a year depending on employment requests from employers.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS Must have all original documents listed: Application, Transcript, Diploma or GED, Birth Certificate, Resume, Driver's License, Social Security Card, and must be able to pass a DOT Physical and or a Physical provided by your PCP. If you are in the Stationary Mechanic Trade a normal physical provided by your Primary Car Physician will work. A DOT is not needed for this trade.
